
## **Maths Chilli Challenge**




Look at the challenges below, choose a level of chilli you want to start with. If you feel confident, have a go at the next set of questions. The answers will be published on Monday.

A. Three thousand, one hundred and six.


B. **9,815**

A 4 digit number has 8 ones. It is rounded to the nearest ten. 50 is subtracted from the number. The result is 7220. What was the original number?
